### Position Summary

The Tower Technician is responsible for installing, inspecting, maintaining, and troubleshooting wireless radio, antenna, coax, fiber, and microwave systems on towers, rooftops, and other elevated structures. This role requires strong climbing ability, mechanical aptitude, safety discipline, and the ability to work long hours in outdoor field conditions.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Install, inspect, and maintain wireless radio and antenna systems on:
    - Towers
    - Rooftops
    - Elevated structures
  - Mount antennas, including:
    - Panel antennas
    - Microwave dishes
    - Remote radio units
  - Run coax, apply connectors, scope fiber runs, and sweep test coax lines and jumpers
  - Install tower equipment, including:
    - Masts
    - Clamps
    - Bracing
    - Structural support
    - Cabling
    - Bolting hardware
  - Complete RF and microwave dish installation from **1 foot to 10 feet** in size
  - Troubleshoot RF and microwave systems
  - Assemble and support the construction of:
    - Monopoles
    - Self-support towers
    - Guyed towers
  - Install power trunk lines
  - Load, transport, and unload tools, equipment, and materials safely
  - Support site cleanup and general upkeep
  - Lead or manage crew members when required
  - Complete all required company documentation and reporting
  - Perform other related duties as assigned

    - Substance screening
